Programs include: Tee Ball for 4/5 year olds and first year 6 year olds (co-ed), Single A (instructional for ages 6-7), Double A (developmental for ages 8-9), Triple A (ages 9-11), Major League (top players, ages 10-12) and Junior League (competitive program, ages 13-14). Please see website for further explanations.**SOFTBALL:** All children attaining ages 6-16 as of December 31st, 2011, are eligible. Programs include: Single A (instructional for ages 6-8, six year olds must have played one year in either Tee Ball or with another league), Double A (developmental for ages 8-9), Triple A (advanced for ages 9-11), Major League (top players, ages 10-12), Junior League (competitive program, ages 13-14, offered only with sufficient participation).**2012 SPRING SEASON SCHEDULE**

Registration:	December 1st, 2011 through March 1st, 2012
Clinics:	See www.beavertonball.com for clinic updates
Tryouts:	February 2012. See www.beavertonball.com for tryout updates
Practices:	Begin as early as March 1st. Days & times to be set by managers
Games:	Around April 1st through June 15th, varying by playing level
Post-Season:	All-star/honors team selection and practices begin June 15th, with tournament play through August 15th, depending upon the age of the player and advancement of the team.

Tryouts

Tryouts help determine League play level according to player's ability, therefore we require baseball players who will be age 9 or older as of April 30th, 2012, or softball players who will be age 9 or older as of December 31st, 2011, to attend tryouts. Players 9 years and older must attend at least one tryout session to be eligible to play at any level. Returning Majors players must also attend a tryout. Experienced 8 year old players wishing to be considered for the AAA playing level may also tryout based on a recommendation from previous year's manager. During tryouts players will be tested on catching, throwing, running & hitting skills. Tryouts are usually held in late to mid-February on the weekend. See www.beavertonball.com for tryout updates.
